

1 me; but I was unable to get a copy of her transcript
2 this morning. She is in court somewhere. I can either
3 have both of them next month, or just go ahead and post
4 them to the website, whichever the board would prefer.

5 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Anybody want to see them
6 prior to being posted this is your chance to speak up;
7 otherwise I say we let her post them to the website; and
8 anyone who reviews them and finds a correction, we can
9 take care of that at our next meeting.

10 The second item is report of collections
11 regarding status of checks from the D. A.'s office. You
12 should all have a sheet that's been past out. I don't
13 think they have a representative here in person; but I
14 do think they have a monthly report for just over four
15 thousand collected.

16 Third is consideration of and approval of
17 applications. I think we have a renewal application.

18 CATHERINE PRESLEY: And a new.

19 JUDGE DOLLINGER: And a new. I don't know
20 if I got -- are they together?

21 JAMES MAKIN: No, they're separated.

22 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay. Is there any
23 irregularity in either of those two?

24 CATHERINE PRESLEY: No, sir.

25 JUDGE DOLLINGER: They're both in order.

1 CATHERINE PRESLEY: Yes, sir.

2 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Any discussion on the
3 renewal from Mrs. Hart? There being no discussion,
4 we'll call for a vote. All of those in favor of
5 approving her renewal:

6 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.

7 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Those opposed?

8 (No response.)

9 JUDGE DOLLINGER: I don't have the new one.

10 MARY GODINA: It's attached.

11 JAMES MAKIN: Under the paper clip.

12 JUDGE DOLLINGER: I asked if they were
13 together. Somebody said no. Okay. Tamara Ritenour,
14 applying as an agent for Keith Day Profession Bail Bond.
15 Is that one also in order?

16 CATHERINE PRESLEY: Yes, sir.

17 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Any discussion on Ms.
18 Ritenour to become an agent? Hearing none, we'll call
19 for a vote. All in favor of approving Ms. Ritenour's
20 application.

21 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.

22 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Opposed?

23 (No response.)

24 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Both of them are approved.

25 CATHERINE PRESLEY: Judge, I'd like the

1 board to know that Thomas Snoddy, doing business as ASAP
2 Bail Bonds was to renew 7/26 of '11. So he's expired.

3 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay. Keith, you might,
4 if you see him mention it to him that his application --

5 CATHERINE PRESLEY: He's chosen to not --

6 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Oh, all right.

7 MAN IN AUDIENCE: It's A-Fast Response Bail
8 Bonds that he's not renewing. It's not ASAP.

9 CATHERINE PRESLEY: Oh, that's correct. I'm
10 sorry. I see where you-all changed the name.

11 JUDGE DOLLINGER: So he's chosen not to
12 renew?

13 MAN IN AUDIENCE: Right.

14 KEITH DAY: Right.

15 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Complaints against
16 bondsmen?

17 MARY GODINA: I don't have any.

18 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Report from the
19 treasurer's office?

20 TIM FUNCHNESS: You have the By Collateral
21 report. I don't have anything to elaborate.

22 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Any questions for Mr.
23 Funchess concerning the bail bond board collateral?
24 Auditor's office?

25 RHONDA BRODE: I do not have a report today.

1 I am sorry. Anyone that's interested in one, I will
2 take your e-mail address and scan it and e-mail it to
3 you. I just came back from vacation and the windows
4 were changed and my computer was torn apart.

5 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Anybody who wants copy of
6 the auditor's report, get with her before she leaves
7 today and it will be forwarded to you.

8 And the last item of business scheduled is
9 to review changes to be made in the local rules. I'm
10 going to take a wild guess that would be the purpose of
11 Mr. Roebuck's attendance today?

12 MR. ROEBUCK: That's what I understand.

13 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay.

14 MR. ROEBUCK: But somehow the proposed new
15 rules have slid by me under my radar.

16 JAMES MAKIN: Then I move we perhaps
17 continue that discussion to the next meeting.

18 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay.

19 JAMES MAKIN: Lupe will be here and Tina.

20 JUDGE LIVELY: I second that.

21 BECKY GARCIA: I have some that's flagged
22 but we can discuss it next month.

23 JUDGE DOLLINGER: We have a motion to table
24 the discussion about changes to be made to the local
25 rules.

1 JUDGE LIVELY: Second.

2 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Second. Anybody have any
3 discussion?

4 CINDY CRUMPLER: I just want to know were
5 they e-mailed, the changes e-mailed?

6 BECKY GARCIA: Tina was taking care of that
7 as far as I know. I just read through the rules and
8 made some notes, some things we weren't doing. We
9 weren't in compliance of our own rules. Some things in
10 here that we started doing now that -- it's just a
11 random order of things.

12 MR. ROEBUCK: So all we have is -- I don't
13 mean all we have. We have notes indicating what the
14 concerns are?

15 BECKY GARCIA: What my concerns were. I
16 know there are were other issues by other members;
17 but --

18 MR. ROEBUCK: All right.

19 CINDY CRUMPLER: Is there a list of that
20 somewhere, what the issues were or what we were supposed
21 to be --

22 BECKY GARCIA: Well, I mean the first thing
23 is on the cover page is says adopted by the Jefferson
24 County bail bond board and it's blank. So, we don't
25 even have our own date of when we adopted our own rules;

1 and what --

2 CINDY CRUMPLER: It was 9/30/08.

3 BECKY GARCIA: Huh?

4 CINDY CRUMPLER: 9/30/08 is what I was told.

5 BECKY GARCIA: Tina can put that in there.

6 There was a few things I noticed that -- in our rules it
7 said that we were posting notices to the county clerk's
8 office which we had stopped doing. I think now we are
9 doing. There was in here that we were supposed to be in
10 accordance with the Robert's Rules, which we weren't;
11 but now we are. I think that the minutes being done and
12 being transcribed and posted; because that was mention
13 inside the rule that we weren't doing but now we are
14 doing. So --

15 LOLITA RAMOS: Your Honor, I'd like to move
16 forward with the motion --

17 BECKY GARCIA: Yeah.

18 LOLITA RAMOS: -- our attorney has been
19 briefed and he has an opportunity to look at these
20 matters.

21 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Okay. We'll call for the
22 question, all those in favor of tabling the discussion
23 on changes, signify by saying aye.

24 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.

25 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Anybody opposed?

1 (No response.)

2 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Hearing none, the motion
3 carries.

4 Anybody have any new business to bring
5 before the bail bond board that's not on the order of
6 business?

7 JUDGE LIVELY: Mr. Makin behind you.

8 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Yes, sir.

9 JAMES MAKIN: Well, after four years I'm
10 cycling off the board. Sonny Cribbs will be taking take
11 my place. I thank you all for wonderful time.

12 BECKY GARCIA: It's been fun, James.

13 LOLITA RAMOS: Who agreed to that?

14 JAMES MAKIN: See, the chairman of the
15 criminal defense section of the bar sits on the bail
16 bond board; and I've really been it for about eight or
17 nine years; so it's time to, you know, someone else come
18 in.

19 JUDGE LIVELY: I'm sorry, could you state
20 your name for the record?

21 JAMES MAKIN: James Makin.

22 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Well, we appreciate your
23 service.

24 JAMES MAKIN: Well, thank you. Thank you.

25 JUDGE DOLLINGER: We look forward to

1 continuing to see you around the courthouse.

2 JAMES MAKIN: I'll be here.

3 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Any other new business?

4 Hearing none, I'll entertain a motion to adjourn.

5 BECKY GARCIA: Motion.

6 JAMES MAKIN: Second.

7 JUDGE DOLLINGER: Motion and seconded. Any

8 discussion? Hearing none, all in favor.

9 BOARD MEMBERS: Aye.

10 (MEETING ADJOURNED.)

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
