Ave. H Reconstruction Team effort with Cities of Nederland & Port Neches

Jefferson County, City of Port Neches and the City of Nederland in a collaborative effort completely rebuilt Ave. H. from Highway 347 to Texas Ave. The new road surface is Asphalt which provides a smooth driving surface. The new roadway has new reflective lane striping and reflectors. The project funding was shared between the cities through an inter-local agreement.

The Jefferson County Precinct 2 Road & Bridge Office is responsible for road & bridge construction and drainage maintenance in the unincorporated areas of Precinct 2. Precinct 2 Road & Bridge currently maintains 93 road & ditch miles, spanning over 120 square miles with approximately 10 bridges. We have inter-local agreements with Port Neches, Nederland and Groves as well as other governmental entities such as PNGISD, NISD, and HFISD to assist them on projects.

Total Detailed Summary Report of Precinct 2 Road Projects which includes road projects in unincorporated areas such as Labelle, Fannett, and Central Gardens areas and Port Neches, Nederland and Groves.

Road & Bridge Precinct 2 hauled a total of **257** dump truck loads of cover stone aggregate; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of **2,040 tons** distributed on road projects.

Distributed a total of **42 tank truck loads** of RS-2 oil; each load at 1,440 gallons; for a total of **50,044 gallons distributed** on road projects.

Hauled a total of **113 dump truck loads** of hot mix asphalt; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of **743 tons of asphalt distributed** and overlay of roadways.

Approximate Total miles of roadway completed: 11 miles
