The staff of Precinct 2 worked tirelessly to dismantle & repaint an old equipment shed that was not being used at another location and relocated it our LaBelle /Fannett equipment yard. ## Jefferson County Precinct 2 Road & Bridge Team

Our 3rd Annual Precinct 2 Appreciation Luncheon was a success. Many thanks to all who have helped, assisted and Supported Road & Bridge Precinct 2 during our 2013 Road building season.



**Total Detailed Summary Report of Precinct 2 Road Projects which includes road projects in unincorporated areas such as Labelle, Fannett, and Central Gardens areas and Port Neches, Nederland and Groves.**

Precinct 2 hauled a total of 427 dump truck loads of cover stone aggregate; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of 2,819 tons distributed on road projects. Distributed a total of 74 tank truck loads of CRS-2 oil; each load at 1,440 gallons; for a total of 85,418 gallons distributed on road projects. Hauled a total of 165 dump truck loads of hot mix asphalt; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of 1,312 tons of asphalt distributed and overlay of roadways.

Approximate Total miles of roadway completed: 13 miles
