Total County road Pct 2 projects distance approximately – 5. miles---NOT including streets in the Cities of Port Neches, Nederland, Groves

In regard to the above mentioned County projects; the Road & Bridge Precinct 2 crews distributed approximately 14 tank truck loads of CRS2 oil; each load approximately 2,100 gallons; for a total of 27,545 gallons distributed on the above county road projects during the 2014 road building and repair season.

They hauled approximately 132 dump truck loads of cover stone road building aggregate; each load at approximately 8 tons per dump truck for an approximate total of 1,052 tons and a distribution rate of approximately 8 trucks of cover stone to one (1) tank load of oil.

In addition, they distributed approximately 0 gallons of prime oil for a total of 4.5 miles of roadway and approximately 11-- 55 gallon barrels of top shield material for 5. miles of roadway.

In regard to the above mentioned Nederland city inter-local agreement projects; the Road & Bridge Precinct 2 crews distributed approximately 12 tank truck loads of CRS2 oil; each load approximately 2,100 gallons; for a total of 22,031 gallons distributed on the above city street projects during the 2014 road building and repair season.

They hauled approximately 90 dump truck loads of cover stone road building aggregate; each load at approximately 8 tons per dump truck for an approximate total of 720 tons and a distribution rate of approximately 8 trucks of cover stone to one (1) tank load of oil.

Precinct 2 School District Projects:

Nederland School district projects: Nederland ISD inter-local agreement project. The Precinct 2 crews hauled approximately 21 loads of hot mix asphalt at 8 tons per load for the new parking area at Helena Elementary for a total of 168 tons hot mix asphalt overlay for this project.

In regard to the above mentioned Port Neches city inter-local agreement projects; the Road & Bridge Precinct 2 crews distributed approximately 9 tank truck loads of CRS2 oil; each load approximately 2,100 gallons; for a total of 15,348 gallons distributed on the above city street projects during the 2014 road building and repair season. They hauled approximately 67 dump truck loads of cover stone road building aggregate; each load at approximately 8 tons per dump truck for a total of 536 tons and a distribution rate of approximately 8 trucks of cover stone to one (1) tank load of oil.

Groves Street Projects:

1. Hogaboom Road compelte rebuild from 347 to 366 and widen curve areas

In regard to the above mentioned Groves city inter-local agreement projects. The Precinct 2 crews assisted with the project only. We hauled approximately 0 loads of cover stone for a total of 0 tons. We distributed 4 tank truck of CRS2 oil for a total of gallons. At their request we distributed CRS-2 at these locations with our distributor truck and provided 2-3 additional dump trucks for transporting aggregate to the sites. We used our rock distributor and have aggregate centrally located as to reduce travel times and fuel costs.

2014 Total Detailed Summary Report of Precinct 2 Road Project including Cities in Pct 2

- Hauled a total of **300 dump truck loads of cover stone aggregate**; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of **2,308 tons** distributed on road projects.
- Distributed a total of **35 tank truck loads** of CRS-2 oil; each load at 2,100 gallons; for a total of **64,924 gallons** distributed on road projects. We hauled an **approximate 300 tons of limestone equal to 51 dump truck loads**.
- Hauled a total of **25 dump truck loads of hot mix asphalt**; each load at approximately 8 tons; for a total of **243 tons of asphalt** distributed and overlay of roadways.
- **Approximate Total miles of roadway completed: 13 miles**
