

- ★ Precinct 2 encompasses over 120 square miles including Nederland Port Neches, Groves, LaBelle and Fannett areas serving the unincorporated areas with roads, bridges and drainage and other county projects.
- ★ There are 10 bridges and 93 miles of roads in Pct 2.
- ★ We assist the cities of Port Neches, Nederland and Groves as well as the School Districts of Nederland & Port Neches-Groves on road and street projects.
- ★ Precinct 2 serves, Labelle, Fannett, Port Neches, Groves, Nederland, and all the unincorporated areas of Pct 2 such as but not limited to: Central Gardens, Hollywood, Beauxart Gardens, Delmonte, Forest Central, Highland North, Grand Chase, Willow Run, and others.

Services Provided by Precinct 2

• **Road Construction**-Reclaim existing base and asphalt surface, reshape, re-compact, stabilize any base failures that were present in the old road, and seal either with a double chip seal or overlay of hot mix asphalt. We assist the Mid County cities and school districts of Pct. 2 with different projects through an inter-local agreement to provide assistance for road construction or other projects as needed or directed.

• **Bridge Construction**- The Texas Department of Transportation does our bridge inspections for the County based on their recommendations our engineering department along with the commissioner's court makes a decision on replacement schedule. Bridge replacement is usually done with contractors by bid process.

• **Drainage work**- We have two Gradalls; one being operated in the west part of the precinct and one being operated in the Mid-County area of the precinct used to recut and cut new ditches to grade with a laser instrument as well as being used for road construction and other county projects as directed. We have a drainage maintenance schedule to maintain drainage for the precinct.

• **Right-of-way-Mowing**- We have a slope mower that we use to mow the bottom, and backside of ditches, and a side mower that is used for mowing the roadway sides of ditches, and tractors with brush hogs for mowing as needed. We have a mowing schedule to maintain these areas.

• **Traffic Control & Street signs**- We maintain all of the street name signs, for public and 911 roads, warning signs, and traffic control signs for approximately 92 miles of roads. We also have one traffic signal that we maintain in a school zone.

• **Maintain Veterans Memorial Park**- Our Precinct and maintenance person helps to maintain the park with various tasks such as building maintenance, mowing, and other maintenance projects as directed.

• **Pct 2 County Building Maintenance**- The Pct 2 Maintenance Department maintains buildings and grounds of the Constable and JP Offices located in Fannett and Mid-County, the Voting office, Environmental Control, Mid-County Tax Office, Juvenile Facility and other County offices and buildings located in Pct 2.

• **Culvert Installation & Repair**- We determine culvert sizes to be used in our Right of Ways for drainage purposes as requested by property owners for access to their property. Once the property owner purchases the approved sized culverts; we install them to grade to meet our drainage purposes and standards.

• **Roadway Striping and Traffic Safety**- Roadway center lines are marked on rural roads with high volume, and/or high speed traffic or as directed. School zone start and stop lines, reflectors and STOP AHEAD signs are marked on the pavement as needed and directed.
