

## **WORKERS' COMPENSATION NOTIFICATION FORM**

TO: ALL JEFFERSON COUNTY EMPLOYEES

Jefferson County has workers' compensation coverage through Tristar Risk Management to protect you. The County has a program, which covers all employees including full-time, part-time, and temporary for any job-related injury, illness, or occupational disease.

You can get more information about your worker's compensation rights from any local Division office or by calling 1-800-252-7031.

You may elect to retain your common law right of action, if no later than five days after beginning employment, you notify the County in writing that you wish to retain your common law right to recover damages from personal injury. If you elect your common law right of action, you cannot obtain workers' compensation income or medical benefits if you are injured.
