Dear Precinct 2 Resident:

It has come to our attention through a drainage survey and analysis by our Pct 2 Drainage Division the County Road Right-of-way shoulder of the roadway in front of your home, or near your property does not meet our grade drainage specifications. The shoulder area is retaining water resulting in standing water on the roadway causing potholes and road failures in front or near your property. When the shoulder of the roadway is built up with soil it acts as a barrier preventing water from draining from the road. We will make every effort to keep the shoulder maintained and will be distributing grass fertilizer on several County right-of-way shoulder areas in order to prevent erosion and restore the grass.

Proper drainage of the roadway is essential to protect the road from potholes and prevent water from standing on road during time of heavy rainfall; we will be re-cutting and surveying the County Right-of-way shoulder area in order to maintain drainage from the road to the ditch in front of your property.

Also, if you observe someone improperly disposing of debris on the county right of way and/or ditch area please make every effort to identify the responsible person(s) by providing a license plate or other description of person or vehicle and notify the Jefferson County Environmental Control Department at 719-5910.

We want to do all we can to keep the County roadway from developing potholes and road base failures from standing water. Our drainage road shoulder maintenance is an important task in protecting and maintaining the roadway.
