RE: Magistrate Appointment for Drug Court Program (JCDI)

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is written to announce the opening for a Magistrate appointment as administrator of the Jefferson County Drug Intervention Program (JCDI). JCDI was established by the Jefferson County Commissioners Court to provide criminal defendants with alcohol, drug, and other related treatment and rehabilitation services. Defendants on probation may have their probation terminated early and their criminal records purged upon successfully completing the JCDI program.

The JCDI Magistrate must be a Jefferson County, Texas resident, and have been licensed to practice law in Texas for at least four years. A magistrate appointed for the JCDI program is selected by the criminal district and county court at law judges, upon consent and approval of the Jefferson County Commissioners Court. A magistrate appointed to administer the JCDI program serves at the will of the appointing judges.

If interested in this position, please send a written response expressing such interest to one of the criminal district or county court at law judges. Those interested in being considered for the JCDI magistrate position must notify the appropriate judge(s) on or before August, 31, 2020.
