

****NOTICE – HOUSE BILL 335****

Passed this Legislative Session, becomes effective September 1, 2003. This Law applies to Constable's Sale conducted after October 1, 2003 requires the following:

1. You must complete and have notarized a REQUEST FOR TAXES DUE from the Jefferson County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office. These forms can be obtained from the Tax Office or online at co.jefferson.tx.us. Based on you request, you will be issued a statement of Taxes Due or no unpaid Taxes Due by the Tax Office. To be eligible to bid at the Constable's Sale, a statement issued with No Unpaid Taxes must be submitted to the Constable prior to the sale. There is a \$10.00 Fee (Cash only) for this statement.
2. An individual may not bid on or purchase property on the name of another individual. An officer conducting the sale may not execute a deed in the name of a deliver a deed to any person other than the person who was the successful bidder. A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS SECTION OF THE LAW COMMITS AN OFFENSE-A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR.
