Contract Award will be based on the lowest qualified bidder, depending on the availability of funds.

Bidders understand the Owner reserves the right to reject any irregular proposal and the right to waive technicalities if such waiver is in the best interest of the Owner and conforms to State and local laws and ordinances pertaining to the letting of construction contracts. Funding availability will be considered in selecting the bid award. The bidder agrees this bid shall be honored and may not be withdrawn for a period of 90 calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

Bidder hereby agrees to commence work under this contract on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" and to fully complete the project within:

30 Calendar Days thereafter.

Bidder further agrees to pay as liquidated damages the sum of **One Thousand** Dollars (**\$1,000.00**) for each calendar day to complete the work beyond the allotted time or as extended by an approved Change Order or Supplemental Agreement.

ITEM P-620 RUNWAY AND TAXIWAY PAINTING is hereby amended with respect to the paragraphs and sections sited below.

Replace Section 620-3.3 as noted:

620-3.3 PREPARATION OF SURFACE. Existing pavement markings are to be removed to the satisfaction of the OWNER in preparation of the layout for the new markings. The specified pavement markings shall be removed without damaging the existing pavement. The methods for removal shall be approved by the Engineer before construction begins. For areas to be repainted, the existing painted surface shall be cleaned by high-pressure water blasting or sand blasting, as required, to remove all foreign material which would reduce the bond between the new paint and the old paint. Use of any chemicals or impact abrasives during surface preparation shall be approved in advance by the Engineer. Grinding of the surface will not be permitted. Removed paint is property of the Contractor and is to be removed from the airport and disposed of by the Contractor according to local regulations and ordinances. Upon completion of paint removal, the surface of the pavement to receive the final markings (at times beyond the limits of the layouts) are to be cleaned and prepared by being free from dirt, grease, oil, laitance, or other foreign material that would reduce the bond between the paint and the pavement. There will be no separate payment for cleaning of the pavement after the marking removal.

Revise the following paragraph before Table 1 in Section 620-3.5 as noted:

The paint shall be mixed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and applied to the pavement with a marking machine at the rate(s) shown in Table 1. The addition of thinner will not be permitted. A period of recommended by the coal tar sealer manufacturer shall elapse between placement of a bituminous surface course or seal coat and application of the paint.

Add the following paragraph after Table 1 in Section 620-3.5 as noted:

Pavement markings shall be completed in two applications. The first application shall be at the application rate specified in Table 1 for "First Pass". The second application shall be at the application rate specified in Table 1 for "Second Pass", placed in the opposite direction of the first pass. All glass beads shall only be included in the final application of the pavement markings.

Replace Section 620-4.1 as noted:

620-4.1 The quantity of runway and taxiway markings to be paid for shall be <u>the number of square feet (square meters) of painting</u> performed in accordance with the specifications and accepted by the Engineer. If multiple pavement marking applications are specified, there will be no separate measurement for payment of "First Pass" marking installation, and runway and taxiway markings are to be paid for shall be the number of square feet (square meters) of painting performed in accordance with the specifications and accepted by the Engineer as "Second Pass" markings.

Add Section 620-4.2 as noted:

620-4.2 Pavement marking removal shall be measured by the lump sum of markings removed in accordance with the specifications and accepted by the Engineer.

Replace Section 620-5.1 as noted:

MODIFCATIONS ITEM P-620

RUNWAY AND TAXIWAY PAINTING

620-5.1 Payment for marking removal shall be made at the contract lump sum price and shall include furnishing all materials and for all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the item.

Payment shall be made at the respective contract <u>price per square foot (square meter)</u> for runway and taxiway painting and <u>when called for</u>, reflective media. This price shall be full compensation for <u>layout of the replaced markings</u>, furnishing all materials and for all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the item.



Bidder Questions

See below for responses to Bidder questions regarding the Runway 16/34 Rehabilitation project at Jack Brooks Regional Airport.

Question 1: The ftp site is not automatically loading. How do you get access to the files? **Answer 1:** There is a secure ftp application that your computer must have to access the ftp site. This application is free on our website at http://www.garverusa.com/ftp/. Follow the on-screen instructions and once the program is loaded, access to the files can be made. The username is: **BPT_RW1634** and the password is: **BPT2BIDDER**. Please note that both the username and password are casesensitive.

Question 2: The specs require 28 days between seal coat and paint. Will that apply to this 30 day contract?

Answer 2: Not necessarily. Please reference Modification to Specification Item P-620.

Question 3: Is water from the paint removal o.k. to dispose of in the in-field?

Answer 3: If the water does not contain any hazardous constituents it may be disposed of in the infield.
