## **CLARIFICATIONS**

**Question**: The schedule in the RFQ indicates that excavation has already started. Can you confirm and clarify?

<u>Answer</u>: There was some excavation previously performed downstream by the Drainage District, but none directly related to this project has been started.

**Question:** We think environmental services will be required. Can you please confirm?

<u>Answer</u>: The Grant Administrator for this project (Griffith, Moseley, Johnson & Associates, Inc./ "GMJ") will achieve HUD/GLO Environmental Clearance and NEPA Review. Any special service such as biology assessment, wetland delineation, or archeology study would be performed by the engineer.

**Question**: Do the Vendor References pertain to all team members or just the Prime Consultant?

<u>Answer</u>: References are to be for the primary respondent to this Request for Statements of Qualification. However, you must meet but are not limited to that format.

**Question**: Are there page limits? Is a particular font size required?

<u>Answer</u>: There is no page limit for responses, but the County does encourage that respondents keep the response to the required documentation & any supporting information that reflects your firm is "the most qualified" respondent for this particular project. There is no required font size.

**Question:** Is there a Section 3 provider firm requirement for the submittal?

<u>Answer</u>: The Texas General Land Office (GLO) requires Section 3. (The County's Section 3 policy is posted on the County website.) The Grant Administrator (GMJ) will monitor for compliance.

<u>Question</u>: Please provide a list of the forms required to be submitted with the Statement of Qualifications.

<u>Answer</u>: Per the submission requirements, all response copies (originals <u>and</u> copies) are to include a full copy of the RFP specifications packet in its entirety and any/all addendum issued.

Any page/form that requires information to be completed should be included – since you are submitting a whole copy of the specifications. If a form/page is non-applicable to your firm, please indicate so on that page (Note "N/A" or "Not Applicable").
