RFQ 21-030/JW Clarifications

Question: Please confirm the DBE participation goal for this project. Page 1 of 24 says 4.81%, while page 19 of 24 has the goal as 1.95%.

<u>Answer</u>: This is a typo within the RFQ specifications. The 2021 DBE Goal is <u>1.95%</u>. The utilization of (DBE) subcontractors does count towards this DBE goal.

Question: Is this a first-time implementation of a PMP for Jack Brooks Regional Airport? If not, are the previous pavement management database (PAVER) and corresponding mapping files available for the selected consultant?

Answer: Yes, this is a first-time Pavement Management Program.

Question: Is a structural evaluation envisioned such as determining the Pavement Classification Number (PCN) for the runways?

<u>Answer</u>: In reference to performing core drills along the pavement to determine if the PCN is uniform for a single runway, this will be addressed during scope negotiations.

Question: Is skid testing requested (as the FAA AC is referenced, 150/5320-12)?

Answer: Yes.

Question: To verify, does the airport want the skid resistance and NDT testing performed?

<u>Answer</u>: We are seeking services required for airports under the most current version of Advisory Circular 150/5380-7B. If a service is not required under the AC, then that can be discussed in scope negotiations.

Question: Is there a minimum font size requirement for the SOQ?

<u>Answer</u>: There is not a minimum font requirement, however we do encourage at minimum a 10-11 size font that is easily readable for the evaluators.

Question: The RFQ states "Statement signed by any sub-consultant that the sub will perform all work as described." Will these signed statements count toward the 30-page limit for the SOQ?

Answer: Yes, these statements will be included in the 30-page limit.

Question: Do we need to submit a Form 1295 with our submission? If so, does Form 1295 count towards the 30-page limit for the SOQ?

<u>Answer</u>: A FORM 1295 will be required at time of award. Respondent may choose to include a completed FORM 1295 in their response. This form will not be counted towards the 30-page limit.

Question: If we include our insurance certifications as evidence of insurance, will that count towards the 30-page limit?

Answer: Insurance documentation will not count towards the 30-page limit.
