Clarifications

Question: Are you able to provide an estimated budget/value range for this project?

Answer: As the County/Airport is requesting Statements of Qualification for this project, an estimated budget/value range is unavailable to potential respondents. Additional Project Information

Landside Road Repairs:

Some the concrete road panels have failed and need repair. We (County/Airport) plan on making selective panel replacements, concentrating on the heavily damaged panels near the Commercial Terminal and along Jerry Ware Drive. The bulk of the road issues are along the same pavement that the tank farm drive is on. The photo on the right is located on Airport 3rd Street, which was originally a taxiway to the GA Terminal, when it was the Commercial Terminal. As you can see in the photo, a few of the panels have failed.

We intend to make full depth replacements, addressing any subbase issues and underground drainage lines that may be in the immediate area that have failed.
