- 1. Q During the months of June through November will the selected caterer be required to store all food products in quantities adequate to feed up to 500 people per meal for four days at their own physical facility or Jefferson County facilities? We believe "its own facilities" refers to the caterer's facility. Please advise.
 - A Yes, "its own facilities" refers to the Contractors facilities.
- 2. Q Given that this contract grants no guaranteed purchase, does the County require that the selected caterer store fresh food ingredients during the months June through November in adequate quantities to provide meals such as those identified in Appendix A? Or would the County consider that the selected caterer be allowed to sore adequate amounts of ancillary products and supplies excluding fresh food such as chicken, ribeye, eggs, etc., understanding that the contracted caterer must still meet requirements to serve meals within 12 hours?
 - A The contracted caterer can store food as they see fit understanding they are required to serve meals within 12 hours of notification from the County.
- 3. Q Understanding that meals are required to be served within the first 12 hours following activation, will the selected caterer be required to stage equipment at Jefferson County Courthouse facilities during the months of June through November, or can the successful bidder mobilize equipment from its own location or another to provide catering services within the 12 hour response time?
 - A The contracted caterer should store mobilization equipment at the location of their choosing, understanding they are required to serve meals within 12 hours of notification.
