This is important for the patient because:

- Many clients do not have reliable transportation and do not like to rely on friends or family for transportation to and from the indigent office.
- The clients will not have to go through third-party resources like social services agencies simply to get an application.
- Some clients may be bedridden and can now apply from their bed.
- In-patient applicants who could apply for the county program from the hospital.
- Inmates who are soon to be released could apply from the county jail prior to being released.
- It allows patients at local substance abuse treatment facilities, who might be eligible for the county indigent program for services provided outside of their substance abuse center, to apply.
- It allows the homeless population to apply for the indigent health care program from local shelters.

IHS shall install the ApplyIHS software portal upon execution of this Addendum. Client shall begin paying for the ApplyIHS portal for an additional monthly consideration of \$275.00 upon installation.

To the Juvenile Board and Director of Juvenile Probation Department Jefferson County, Texas

Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

Opinions

We have audited the financial statements of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department Grant Funds of Jefferson County Juvenile Probation Department (Department), as of and for the year ended August 31, 2023, the statement of revenues, expenditures and changes in fund balances-budget and actual-regulatory basis for the year ended August 31, 2023, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the Department's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents.

Unmodified Opinion on Regulatory Basis of Accounting

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the revenue earned and expenditures incurred compared to budgeted revenues and expenditures of the Department's Texas Juvenile Justice Department Grant Funds, as of August 31, 2023, for the year then ended in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) as described in Note 1.

Basis for Opinions

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS) and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the Department and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinions.

Emphasis of Matter – Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 1 of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared on the basis of accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD), which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our opinions on the Department's Regulatory Basis of Accounting are not modified with respect to this matter.



Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting practices prescribed or permitted by TJJD to demonstrate compliance with TJJD's regulatory basis of accounting. Management is also responsible for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the Department's ability to continue as a going concern for twelve months beyond the financial statement date, including any currently known information that may raise substantial doubt shortly thereafter.

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinions. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS and *Government Auditing Standards* will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, they would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user based on the financial statements.

In performing an audit in accordance with GAAS and Government Auditing Standards, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to
 fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures
 include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the amounts and disclosures in the financial
 statements.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Department's internal control. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluate the overall presentation of the financial statements.
- Conclude whether, in our judgment, there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the Department's ability to continue as a going concern for a reasonable period of time.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audit.

Other Reporting Required by Government Auditing Standards

In accordance with *Government Auditing Standards*, we have also issued our report dated February 28, 2024, on our consideration of the Department's internal control over financial reporting and on our tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements and other matters. The purpose of that report is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control over financial reporting and compliance and the results of that testing, and not to provide an opinion on the effectiveness of the Department's internal control over financial reporting or on compliance. That report is an integral part of an audit performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* in considering the Department's internal control over financial reporting.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED AUGUST 31, 2023

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

<u>Entity</u>

The Texas Juvenile Justice Department Grant Funds of Jefferson County (the "Funds") were established to account for juvenile probation services funded by the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) in Jefferson County, Texas.

The Funds provide separate accountability as required by TJJD under the State Financial Assistance Contract. The Funds are used to account for each separate program, matching funds and all related expenditures incurred.

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements were prepared in conformity with the accounting practices prescribed by TJJD, which prescribe policies and procedures for county probation departments and which constitute a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. These accounting practices include the following:

- The financial statements are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. Revenues are recorded when all eligibility requirements have been met and expenditures are recorded when incurred.
- The accompanying financial statements do not represent financial statements prepared in accordance with provisions for governmental funds as prescribed by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board.
- The accompanying financial statements are prepared in a format to facilitate uniform financial reporting by county probation departments.

2. RECONCILIATION OF INTEREST EARNED

Idle funds were maintained in an interest-bearing account. The reconciliation of interest earned on funds received from TJJD is as follows:

TJJD disburses funds to Jefferson County Juvenile Probation Department on a cost reimbursement basis. The Department did not receive any Title IV-E funds during fiscal year 2023.

5. FINANCIAL MATCH REQUIREMENTS

To receive Texas Juvenile Department state funds, the juvenile probation departments are required to certify that the amount of local or county funds expended for juvenile services is equal to or greater than the amount spent in the 2006 county fiscal year, excluding construction and capital outlay expenses unless waived in accordance with provisions of the State Financial Assistance Fund grant.
