

defendant go near any residence, school, job site, or other location frequented by the alleged complainant/victim;

4. A defendant whose indictment charges any offense listed below shall not operate any motor vehicle illegally and unless the vehicle is equipped with an interlock device mechanism that makes impractical the operation of the vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator; and said device shall be installed at the defendant's expense with **written verification of such installation being submitted to the Court on or before the date scheduled for the defendant's initial appearance;**

-Any subsequent offense under Texas Penal Code Section 49.04 (Driving While Intoxicated), 49.05 (Flying While Intoxicated), 49.06 (Boating While Intoxicated)

-Any offense under Texas Penal Code Section 49.045 (Driving While Intoxicated with Child Passenger), 49.07 (Intoxication Assault), 49.08 (Intoxication Manslaughter)

5. The defendant shall as soon as reasonable possible, orally and in writing, report any arrest relating to any other criminal matter to the Court(s) in which defendant has posted bail bonds; and,


6. A defendant's failure to fully adhere to the Bond Conditions as set forth herein can result in the defendant's bond to be revoked, modified, or otherwise altered by the Court in accordance with law.
