

4. A defendant whose indictment charges any offense listed under chapter 49 of the Texas Penal Code shall not operate any motor vehicle illegally and unless the vehicle is equipped with an interlock device mechanism that makes impractical the operation of the vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator; and said device shall be installed at the defendant's expense with written verification of such installation being submitted to the Court on or before the date scheduled for the defendant's initial appearance; and;

5. The defendant shall as soon as reasonable possible, orally and in writing, report any arrest relating to any other criminal matter to the Court(s) in which defendant has posted bail bonds.
