### DAY 1 ACADEMY CLASSROOM

#### COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Successful completion of this course provides the student with a basic certification as an operational law enforcement sniper.

#### PRE-REQUISITES:

Student must be currently assigned or expect to be assigned by the agency chief administrator as a law enforcement sniper. Students should be in good physical condition and possess above average marksmanship skills. SWAT supervisors welcome.

#### EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Bolt-action or semi-auto, scoped, precision rifle, .223 or .308 caliber, (Capable of 1 minute of angle accuracy or better), 400 rounds MATCH GRADE ammunition, Weapons cleaning equipment, Hydration system/Camelbak, Callout gear and uniform, Note taking materials, Pack/rucksack, Shooting mat, Sling, Data book (NOTE: Storm Tactical data book preferred), Eye and ear protection, Sunscreen, Shooting aids, Rear bag, Bipod, etc.

TOPICS COVERED: Ballistics/Zeroing, Fieldcraft, Case studies, Marksmanship, Position shooting, Weapon maintenance, Operational procedures, Low light/Night shooting, Moving targets (time permitting).
